Dear Parent/Carer

Next September may seem like a long way off, but planning for your child's next steps has already started. Like last year, many colleges started to accept applications mid/late November, sixth form applications across many schools open January/February, and many apprenticeship vacancies open in January too.

I am writing to you today to highlight some key dates and events designed to support your child in planning their next steps. Our aim is for all students to find a post-16 pathway which will allow them to reach their goals and potential, whilst always ensuring they have a Plan B.

School Events and Support

Mock Interview Day: On 11th October 2024, all students in year 11 will have the opportunity for a 1-1 interview with a local employer. This will allow the students to put the skills they've learned during their time at Morton Academy into practice.

1:1 Careers Advice and Guidance Appointments: During this term students will all have an appointment with a Level 6 qualified Careers Advisor to discuss next steps and post-GCSE options. This will be followed up with a document containing suggested next steps and support for your child.

Careers Fair: On Monday 25th November all students in year 11 will visit the careers fair where they will meet over 20 local employers to find out more about opportunities within the local area, but can also talk with staff from the local colleges, and apprenticeship providers.

Personal Development (PD) lessons: For the autumn term PD lessons will have a careers focus. The lessons will cover topics such as: planning your next steps, CV writing, interview skills, etc.

We also keep students informed of other Sixth Form Open Evenings, whenever we get passed this information.
