Christmas Pantomime – The Little Mermaid

I am delighted to inform you that we would like to give your child the chance to broaden their cultural experience with the opportunity to see a live performance, therefore, we are organising a trip to see the Christmas Pantomime, The Little Mermaid at the Theatre Royal at Newcastle on Thursday, 28th November 2024.

Students will be transported by coach leaving the academy at 11:30am and returning to school approximately 6.30pm. We ask that students pay a voluntary contribution of £24.68 this is to cover the cost of the ticket and transport. However, if we do not receive enough contributions unfortunately the trip will not be able to go ahead. All students must be in full school uniform and require a packed lunch.

To secure our tickets we ask that payment is received no later than, <u>Monday, 24th June 2024.</u> Unfortunately, we are unable to offer an extension on the deadline date due to the terms and conditions with the theatre.

We have 47 spaces available, and those places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. (Students will secure their place through payment received via Parent Pay). Students must also have been consistently well behaved and making good progress in school to be allowed to attend the trip. The Principal will have the final decision on which students will attend. If payment is received and your child does not meet the criteria a refund will be given.

Any students late to school on the day will not be allowed to attend the Pantomime; unfortunately, a refund will not be given.
