Year 7 Residential – Kepplewray March 2025

We are delighted to inform you that we are organising a residential to Kepplewray which is situated in Broughton in Furness, Cumbria. The trip will take place on Wednesday, 12th March to Friday, 14th March 2025. (Further information will be sent home when the final numbers are confirmed). We are pleased to have confirmed the booking with Kepplewray as we know how popular the venue is with school groups.

Residential courses organised by the Academy are optional, but an invaluable part of the curriculum for excellence. Students benefit hugely from the experience while taking part in a range of exciting activities within an educationally rich environment. It goes without saying that the safety and wellbeing of your child is the top priority of both the Academy and Kepplewray. Kepplewray have been arranging residential visits for many years and operates their centre and activities to the highest standard of safety.

We would like to offer this opportunity to all our year 7 students, however, we are only able to offer 35 places, if we are oversubscribed we will look to run a second trip. Places will be issued on a first come first served basis. The cost of the trip will be approximately £257.00, this will include staffing, return travel by coach, full board, accommodation, bedding, and two full days of activities. (Please note the costing may change due to numbers). To confirm and secure our booking, we would require an £80 deposit (non-refundable) no later, than Friday, 11th October 2024. The full balance would be required by Friday 31st January 2025.

Unfortunately, we are unable to offer an extension on payments due to the terms and conditions of the Kepplewray Centre. If you feel you are unable to meet the payment deadlines, please do not commit your child to the trip. All payments must be paid via Parent Pay. If you are unable to access Parent Pay, please contact the Finance department at the Academy.

If your child would like to attend the residential, please return the reply slip to your child's tutor by Wednesday, 2nd October 2024.

Please note that the offer of a place on the trip is dependent on the student's school record including factors such as attendance, progress and behaviour. The Academy reserves the right to withhold or withdraw the offer of a place at the discretion of the Principal.
